Geographic Location


Cyprus is an island in the Eastern Basin of the Mediterranean Sea. It is the third largest island in the Mediterranean and the world's 80th largest island by area. It is located south of Asia Minor, the Anatolian peninsula of the Asian (or Eurasian) mainland (part of Turkey), so it may be included in Western Asia or the Middle East. Cyprus is close to Southern Europe, and Northern Africa, and has had lengthy periods of mainly Greek, Turkish, and Western European influence.

The island is dominated by two mountain ranges, the Troodos Mountains and the Kyrenia Mountains or Pentadaktylos, and the central plain, the Mesaoria, between them.

Area: Total: 9,250 km2 / Land: 9,240 km2 / Water: 10 km2 Coastline: 648 km

Climate

The Mediterranean climate, warm and rather dry, with rainfall mainly between November and March, favors agriculture. In general, the island experiences mild wet winters and dry hot summers. Variations in temperature and rainfall are governed by altitude and, to a lesser extent, distance from the coast. Hot, dry summers from mid-May to mid-September and rainy, rather changeable winters from November to mid-March are separated by short autumn and spring seasons.





Education

Education in Cyprus is overseen by the Ministry of Education and Culture. The education system is divided into pre-primary education (ages 3–6), primary education (ages 6–12), secondary education (ages 12–18) and higher education (ages 18+). Full-time education is compulsory for all children aged between 5 and 15. State-provided schooling including higher education is paid for by taxes.

There is also a parallel system of accredited independent schooling, and parents may choose to educate their children by any suitable means. Private school and university fees are not usually covered by the state.

Cyprus Economy

The economy of Cyprus is classified by the World Bank as a high-income economy, and was included by the International Monetary Fund in its list of advanced economies in 2001. Erratic growth rates in the 1990s reflected the economy's vulnerability to swings in tourist arrivals, caused by political instability on the island and fluctuations in economic conditions in Western Europe. On 1 January 2008, the country adopted the euro as its official currency, replacing the Cypriot pound at an irrevocable fixed exchange rate of CYP 0.585274 per EUR 1.00.



The recent discoveries of hydrocarbons within Cyprus EEZ and the massive discovery of the Zohr gas field in the Egyptian waters, which is very close to the Cypriot acreages, has attracted a lot of attention internationally and has created locally a lot of optimism about the future. With an estimated 50-60 trillion cubic feet (tcf) within its



Paphos' famous locations

Chloraka

Chloraka is in the ideal location for purchasing property, it has all necessary amenities including supermarkets, shops, bakeries, banks, pharmacies, doctors, petrol station to name a few and is only minutes drive to Paphos Old Town, Paphos Harbour or in the other direction Coral Bay and beautiful sandy beaches. Chloraka is famous for the 'Agios Georgios' boat that was used to import ammunition for the Liberation Struggle in 1955-59 and in a bad storm crashed into the rocks in a sheltered area by the coast and to this day is still there. There are schools and nursery's within the village including a beautiful large Greek Orthodox Church also called 'Agios Georgios'. This suburb of Paphos is also host to Akritas Chlorakas a Cypriot Second Division football team. Along the coastline of Chloraka are hotels, villas and apartments, perfect for friends and family wanting to visit the island. There are restaurants and tavernas that serve an array of cuisine including traditional Cypriot Meze, international dishes and even a fish & chip shop!

Kissonerga

Kissonerga is a lovely village in South West Cyprus in an area famous for the cultivation of banana plantations, this area is known as the Ktima Lowlands. Kissonerga is an ideal location for purchasing property as it is located just minutes drive to Coral Bay and in the other direction just minutes to Paphos Town and Paphos Harbour and along this coastal road is a regular bus service and several hotels, mini-markets, numerous bars and tavernas serving international and local cuisine. Coral Bay is where you will find two wonderful sandy beaches and an abundance of activities, restaurants and bars and perfect for entertaining families and friends that visit. Within Paphos Harbour there is the famous Castle, plenty of restaurants and taverna's, boats for day trips and many shops and supermarket. The village of Kissonerga has all amenities including small supermarket, shops, banks, restaurants and bars plus a pharmacy.

Mesoyi

Mesoyi is a traditional village located in an elevated position on the hillside just minutes drive from Paphos. Being in such an elevated position gives most properties for sale in this area wonderful sea and coastline views. The village is located just off the Paphos to Polis main road which has all necessary amenities including banks, supermarkets, and shops including an abundance of furniture shops. There are a handful of local tavernas within the village where you can enjoy the local produce and cuisine. In the heart of Mesogi is the Greek Orthodox Church. Mesogi neighbours the villages of Tremithousa. Only minute's drive can take you into Pano Paphos, the main town and approximately 8 minutes you can be at the beach.

Tala

Tala is a wonderful village located on the hill and being set in an elevated position it is perfect to property purchasers that dream of having panoramic sea views. The village itself has shops, a bank, pharmacy, school and a traditional village square where you can enjoy local cuisine at one of the tavernas or just a glass of wine in one of the bars and enjoy watching the world go by. Only minute's drive takes you down the hill to Pano Paphos and Chloraka where there are larger supermarkets and shops. In the other direction is the area of Coral Bay where you can find two wonderful sandy beaches and an abundance of activities like go-karting, horse riding, Paphos Zoo and more plus restaurants and tavernas that serve both international dishes and local cuisine including traditional Cypriot meze, perfect for entertaining families and friends that visit. At the top of the hill in Tala is the famous St Neophytos Monastery named after Neophytos.

PAPHOS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Pafos International Airport is a joint civil-military public airport commonly used by tourists on vacation in western Cyprus, providing access to popular resorts such as Coral Bay, Limassol (about 50 km (31 mi) south-east) and Paphos itself.

According to the airport operator, Paphos Airport served 1,744,011 passengers in 2007. A new terminal opened at Paphos in November 2008.

Passenger facilities include 28 check-in desks, 1 special baggage check-in, 7 gates, 22 aircraft stands, a bank, restaurants, cafeterias, bars, a duty-free shop and a gift shop. Other facilities include a tourist help desk, car rental, first aid, a baby/parent room and disabled access facilities. Refrigerated storage, health officials, and X-ray equipment are among some of the facilities provided for cargo. Furthermore, loading platforms and forklifts are also available.

The main airlines flying from and to Paphos Airport connecting Cyprus to several countries are: EasyJet, Ryanair, Brussels Airlines, British Airways, Thomas Cook World, Transavia Holland, Urals Airlines, Transaero Airlines, jet2.com, BH Air, TUS Airways, Tui fly Netherlands.



SMART HOME

Home Automation System

A smart home, or smart house, is a home that incorporates advanced automation systems to provide the inhabitants with sophisticated monitoring and control over the building's functions. For example a smart home may control lighting, temperature, multi-media, security, window and door operations, as well as many other functions.

Smart homes use 'home automation' technologies to provide home owners with 'intelligent' feedback and information by monitoring many aspects of a home. For example, a smart home's refrigerator may be able to catalogue its contents, suggest menus, recommend healthy alternatives, and order replacements as food is used up. A smart home might even take care of feeding the cat and watering the plants.

Many new homes are being built with the additional wiring and controls which are required to run advanced home automation systems.
